Purpose of Conference:

To provide an educational dairy cattle nutrition conference for people who furnish nutritional recommendations, advice, and products to dairy farmers. The intended audience includes feed company representatives and sales people, independent nutrition consultants, veterinarians, and university personnel.

The Tri-State Dairy Nutrition Conference started in 1991, and in 2018, there were 529 conference attendees.

The majority of attendees are from the tri-states of Indiana, Michigan, and Ohio along with Illinois, Kentucky, New York, Pennsylvania, Wisconsin, and Canada. In total, attendees were from 30 states & 6 countries.
